Say each picture. Circle the ones that have the /a/ sound.



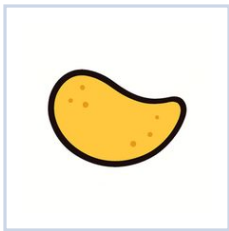

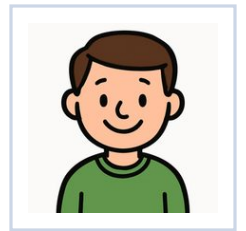
