Say each picture. Circle the ones that have the /d/ sound.



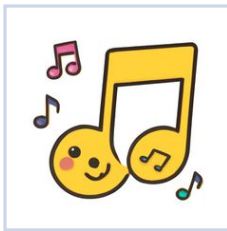

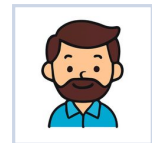

Read each word. Draw a line to its picture.

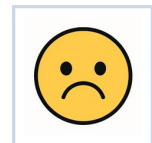
