- Stop while it's fun. Half a sheet today is fine.

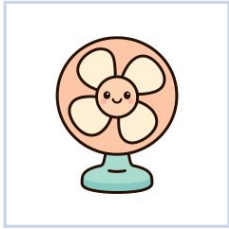
1 Trace and write f

Say /f/ as you trace each gray f. Then write your own on the empty line.

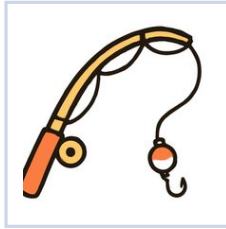

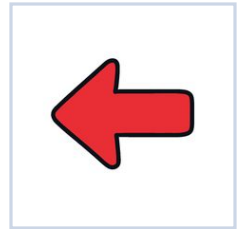
