- Stop while it's fun. Half a sheet today is fine.

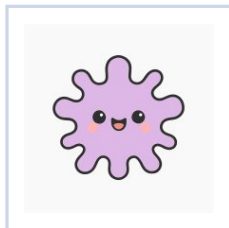
1 Trace and write i

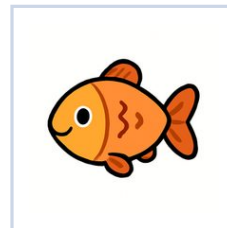
