2 Find the /r/ sound

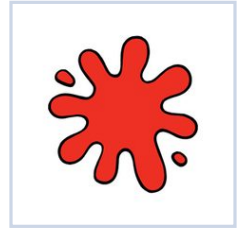

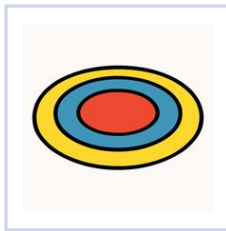

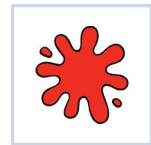
