Say each picture. Circle the ones that have the /v/ sound.



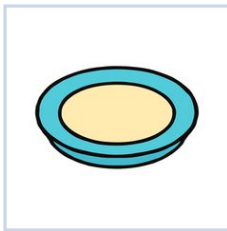
