Say each picture. Circle the ones that have the /w/ sound.



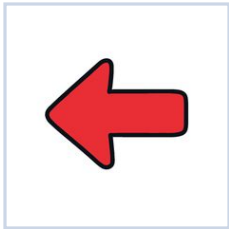

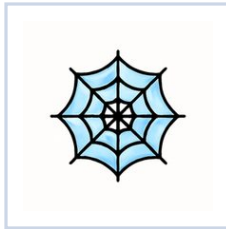
