

Common Homophones

Same sound, different spelling, different meaning.

there / their / they're

a place / owns / they are

Examples: put it there, their book, they're happy

to / too / two

toward / also, very / the number 2

Examples: go to school, me too, two dogs

your / you're

owns / you are

Examples: your coat, you're late

its / it's

owns / it is

Examples: its tail wagged, it's raining

here / hear

this place / with your ears

Examples: come here, I hear you

for / four

on behalf of / the number 4

Examples: a gift for you, four cats
