How to use this worksheet

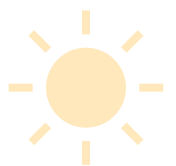
- 1 Some words are split into two red chunks (like s - now) — say each chunk out loud, then blend them together into one word.

- 3 Write the complete word on the blank line.
- 4 Check your spelling against the printed word once you're done.

Example — this is what a correct answer looks like:

sn - **ow** -> **snow**

Try one word a day instead of the whole page at once — rotating through the list this way covers it all in about two weeks without a big session.

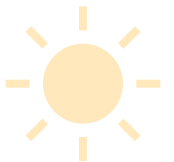

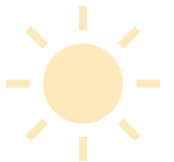
