How to use this worksheet

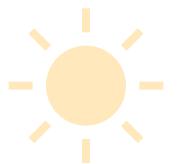
- 1 Some words are split into two red chunks (like b - ag) — say each chunk out loud, then blend them together into one word.
- 2 Other words are shown whole — just read them normally.
- 3 Write the complete blended word on the blank line.
- 4 Check your spelling against the printed word once you're done.

Example — this is what a correct answer looks like:

b - ed -> bed

Tip

Work through one vowel at a time — don't mix vowels until each one is solid. Start with short A, then E, I, O, U.
