

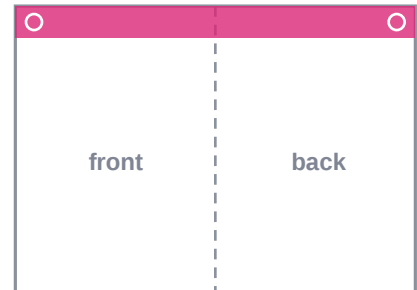
Magic E Flashcards: cap -> cape

12 double-sided cards · 3.5 x 2.5 in (8.9 x 6.4 cm) · 4 cards per page

12 fold-over cards: the short word on the front, the same word with a magic e on the back (cap -> cape, kit -> kite, tub -> tube).

HOW TO MAKE THE CARDS

- 1 Print at 100% ("Actual size", not "Fit to page"). Check: the square below should measure exactly 1 inch.
- 2 Use cardstock (160-200 gsm) if you can. Plain paper works too.
- 3 Cut along the solid gray outline of each pair.
- 4 Fold on the dashed line so both printed sides face out. Glue or tape inside.
- 5 Punch the circle and add a binder ring to keep the deck together (optional).



cut the solid line
fold the dashed line



If this square isn't exactly 1 inch (2.54 cm), turn off "Fit to page" and print again.

HOW TO PLAY

- Read the front (short vowel), then flip: the magic e makes the vowel say its name.
- Before flipping, ask: "What will it say with a magic e?"
- Lay out all the fronts; your child finds the card that turns into a picture you name.

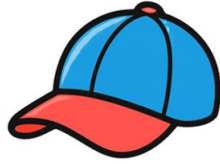

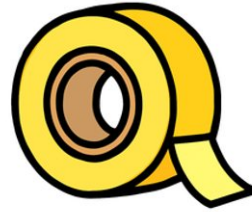

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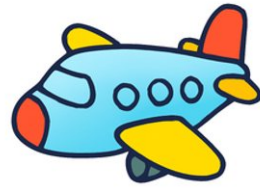
