How to use this worksheet

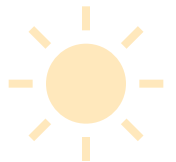
- 1 Read the short word out loud.

Practice one vowel group at a time — mixing them too early causes more mix-ups than it fixes.

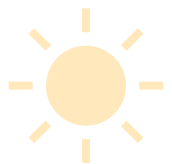
