## How to use this worksheet

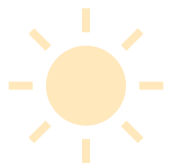
- 1 Say each letter sound out loud first: s, a, t, p, i, n (and m, d, g, o, c, k for Unit 2).
- 2 Some words are split into two red chunks — say each chunk, then blend them together into one word.
- 3 Write the complete blended word on the blank line.
- 4 Once every word on a unit's page is easy, move to the next unit in the phonics-order-which-letter-first guide.

**Example — this is what a correct answer looks like:**

**s - at** -> sat

### Tip

Don't add Unit 2 words until Unit 1 is completely solid — the point of this order is depth before breadth.

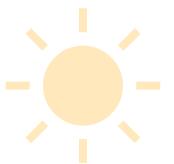
