How to use this worksheet

- 1 Some words are split into two red chunks (like st - ar) — say each chunk out loud, then blend them together, listening for the bossy-R sound.
- 2 Notice the r-controlled spelling (ar, or, er, ir, or ur).
- 3 Write the complete blended word on the blank line.
- 4 Check your spelling against the printed word once you're done.

Example — this is what a correct answer looks like:

f - ern -> fern

Tip

er, ir, and ur all sound identical — spelling them correctly is a matter of visual memory, not sounding-out. The sort worksheet in this pack drills exactly that.
