How to use this worksheet

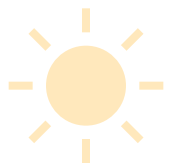
- 1 Some words are split into two red chunks (like c - orn) — say each chunk out loud, then blend them together into one word.

- 3 Write the complete word on the blank line.
- 4 Check your spelling against the printed word once you're done.

Example — this is what a correct answer looks like:

c - orn -> corn

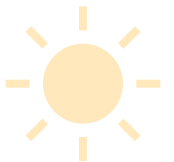

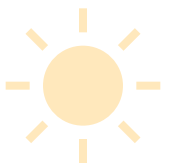
