How to use this worksheet

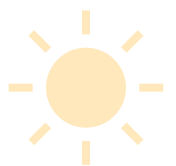
- 1 Some words are split into two red chunks — say each chunk out loud, then blend them together, listening carefully to the vowel sound.
- 2 Notice how the word spells that sound — the vowel sound chart shows every common spelling.
- 3 Write the complete blended word on the blank line.
- 4 Check your spelling against the printed word once you're done.

Example — this is what a correct answer looks like:

c - ar -> car

Tip

Use this as a spelling reference whenever your child asks 'how do I write that sound?' — look up the sound family, then teach the most common spelling first.
