How to use this worksheet

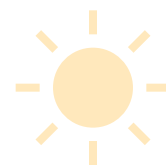
- 1 Do 5 minutes most days — not every single day. Consistency matters more than a perfect streak.
- 2 Use that day's word: sound it out, blend it, then use it in one sentence (swap in your own word if you'd rather).
- 3 Check the box once the 5 minutes are done.
- 4 Don't introduce new content — this period is purely about keeping existing skills fresh, ready for a quick check-in when term starts again.
